Landscape Painting In Central Park

Most of the following supplies may be purchased at the League's art supply store, located in the lobby.

Planning is very important when painting outdoors because you must bring everything you need with you and yet you want to bring as little as needed to lighten the load.

Half Box French Easel is recommended. If you have your own portable easel or Pochade Box please bring that.

Painting Bag: 'Martin' Just Stow It Backpack which can hold all of your painting supplies. They also sell one with wheels and a handle.

Paint: Flake White, Cadmium Yellow Lemon, Cadmium Yellow Deep, Raw Siena, Burnt Siena, Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Viridian, Alizarin Crimson and Van Dyke Brown. **Optional:** Cadmium Red and Yellow Ochre.

Brushes:

Bristle Brushes - Flat #8, #6 #2 - Bright #12 Synthetic Brushes - Flat #8, #6, #2 Short Handle #6 Round

Canvas:

Any size up to 18x14 will be easily accommodated by the easel. Ask yourself if you will be creating a new painting/oil sketch each week (smaller canvases) or one painting over multiple weeks (larger canvas).

Other:

Grey disposable paper palette with thumb hole

Metal Turp Pot with scrubber inside

2 oz or 4 oz plastic squeeze bottle for linseed oil.

Paper towels (about 8 Bounty select-a-size sheets should be more than enough per session
